Summer VolunTEEN Program

Who can apply?

- Teens ages 13-18
- Those who can commit to volunteering for at least 16 hours during the summer
- Those who have permission from a parent or guardian
- Those who have transportation to the library

What do volunteers do?

- Tidy library areas and assist with shelving (must be able to alphabetize!)
- Help with kids' events
- Work at Summer Reading table
- Tend to library book drop regularly
- Assist with other tasks as assigned

When do volunteers work?

- Times are based on the availability of volunteers and the needs of the library
- Be available to work between May 22 and July 28

Why should I volunteer?

- Learn job skills and values
- Make a difference in your community
- Feel good about yourself
- Make friends and have fun!

How do I apply?

1. Print and fill out the Summer VolunTEEN Application. Turn in your completed application at the Youth Services desk by March 27.
2. You will be contacted for an interview if there is a current position available.
3. After the interview, accepted volunteers must attend a mandatory orientation before the VolunTEEN summer experience begins.

Applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis. There are a limited number of positions available, and unfortunately we may not be able to accept everyone who applies. If you are not selected the first time you apply, please try again next summer.
